The main objection must be to the addition of an extra 600 houses on the A420 – it is already full to capacity and there are numerous other developments, e.g. in Faringdon and just this side of Swindon, which will make this road much fuller and more dangerous than it already is. Most work opportunities are in Oxford or on the other side of Oxford so most new residents will be on the A420 and Botley Rd at least twice a day, getting us ever closer to complete gridlock. The notion that traffic will be no worse by 2031 is risibly absurd. The road past Fyfield is already one of the main bottlenecks. A new roundabout near Fyfield will worsen the problem, encouraging still more drivers to rat-run through Netherton and Tubney.

I don't think the planners have complied with their duty to cooperate and consult. It is clear that EVERY resident of Fyfield is against the plan and feels strongly that it will impact negatively on the quality of life in this old village. Branding it as 'east of Kingston Bagpuize' is disingenuous – this is Fyfield land. For St John's College to consider selling this land (at vast profit) against the known wishes of every resident of the village is a betrayal of the history of the college (whose history began in Fyfield) not that that is relevant to VOWH DC or the main reason for objecting to the plan.
