As we have only recently moved to a new property in Wantage, I am unable to comment in detail. However, we have experience of living for a short time in Faringdon and I wish to add to the many concerns expressed by local residents in Faringdon and Wantage that the current Draft Local Plan is not sound as there is inadequate infrastructure delivery planned.

I understand that there is an urgent need to produce a Local Plan and that it is based on strongly disputed SHMA forecasts for housing needs. If these housing need forecasts cannot be reduced, then there must be more plans for better transport infrastructure, especially roads that will be used by commuters: both North-South (A34 overloaded already) and East West (especially with major new housing planned for Faringdon and Wantage without matching local employment prospects).
