Any person who makes representations about the Draft Charging Schedule may request the right to be heard by the examiner. Such a request must be made in writing before the end of this consultation on 23 March 2015. Representations may also be accompanied by a request to be notified, at a specified address, of any of the following:

- That the draft charging schedule has been submitted to the examiner in accordance with section 212 of Planning Act 2008;
- The publication of the recommendations of the examiner and the reasons for those recommendations; and
- The approval of the charging schedule by the charging authority.

Any person who has made representations about the Draft Charging Schedule may withdraw those representations at any time by giving notice in writing to the Council either by e-mail or by post at the address given above.
