## RE: PROPOSED MODIFICATION TO THE PART 2 PLAN REGARDING CORE POLICY 13A: OXFORD GREEN BELT AND THE SETTLEMENT OF SHIPPON 22 AUGUST 2018

- During the Dalton Barracks site Hearing Session on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> July, the Inspector requested that the council consider a modification to Core Policy 13a: Oxford Green Belt relating to the settlement of Shippon and the proposed development at Dalton Barracks.
- The proposed modification seeks to provide further clarity that the settlement of Shippon (including the proposed development at Dalton Barracks) is inset to the Green Belt. This modification follows a consistent approach to Core Policy 13: Oxford Green Belt in the adopted Local Plan 2031 Part 1: Strategic Sites and Policies.
- 3. The proposed modification to Core Policy 13a: Oxford Green Belt is as follows:

## **Core Policy 13a: Oxford Green Belt**

The Council's approach to development within the Oxford Green Belt is set out in Core Policy 13 (Local Plan 2031: Part 1).

The Green Belt boundary is amended to reflect the additional site allocation at Dalton Barracks made through Core Policy 8b: Additional Site Allocations for Abingdon-on-Thames and Oxford Fringe Sub-Area. This is shown by the Adopted Policies Map and Figure 2.3 and Appendix L to address the agreed quantum of unmet housing need for Oxford at Dalton Barracks (Shippon)

THE SETTLEMENT OF SHIPPON (INCLUDING THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT AT DALTON BARRACKS) IS INSET TO THE GREEN BELT AS SHOWN ON THE ADOPTED POLICIES MAP.
