Matter 13.1: Viability, Delivery, Monitoring and Contingency

We do not believe development on sites 3, 4, 5, 6, and 24 is deliverable because:

- Part of site 5 is a playing field which was bequeathed, in perpetuity, to the Parish to be used as a playing field
- Part of site 5 is owned by a landowner who purchased the field with the sole purpose of preventing any development on it
- Sites 3, 5 and 6 are under multiple ownership
- Site 6 has medieval ridge and furrow land formations which have historic significance
- Part of site 24 is the Cumnor Cricket Club ground
- Part of the sweeping open countryside in site 4 lies within the Cumnor Conservation Area.
