Response to VWHDC's Green Belt Note by Christine Wootton (828086)

I would like to draw the inspector's attention to the fact that Area T on the map of sites proposed for release from the Oxford Green Belt has a covenant and a legal agreement on it, both signed by Radley College, the present landowner, confirming that they would not build on this land. The covenant was made between the vendor of the land and Radley College and the legal agreement was made between the County Council, which included the local councils, and Radley College. It seems therefore that it is unnecessary to withdraw the site's green belt status.

This site was previously referred to as 'a field bordering Twelve Acre Drive and Radley Road'. This is the first time I have seen it referred to as Site T so I feel that it is a new submission and the inspector should be made aware of it.
