As already noted the Green Belt Review (November 2014) assesses land around Botley which includes North Hinksey. This is consistent with Core Policy 13 which highlights development being permitted in the following settlements which are inset to the green belt (as shown on the adopted policies map) and includes Botley but excludes North Hinksey. This is on the assumption that North Hinksey in respect of the application of Core Policy 13 is included within Botley. Otherwise there is a disconnect between this policy, the Green Belt amendment at North Hinksey and the remainder of the plan. The above point is reinforced by the omission of North Hinksey from (V) in the policy which refers to the policy within the green belt at these smaller villages most of which are all washed over. North Hinksey is part of the Botley inset to the Green Belt. Clearly in this context North Hinksey is not considered a smaller village and should therefore be considered as part of Botley for the purposes of the local plan suite of policies.

The sustainable characteristics of North Hinksey highlighted above reinforce this point.
