Officer summary:

- 1 Sites 1, 2, 3, 4, 12, and 13 are within the Green Belt or AONB, this is inappropriate. Allocating development in the Green Belt would weaken the five purposes of the Green Belt and conflict with Paragraph 80 of the NPPF.
- 2 Sites in more sustainable locations outside of the Green Belt and AONB are available for development such as the land known as "Milton Parish west of the A34, Milton Heights".
- 3 Allocating the above site would help to meet an immediate housing need in the district fromed through past undersupply of housing.
