I would like to add a consideration I omitted to include in my original email and about which I am very concerned, viz. that there is a proven risk from diesel particulates to the health of the inhabitants of the proposed houses in Valley Park and other sites near to the A34.

"New schools, care homes and hospitals should be built far away from major roads because of the dangers of air pollution, a report by the parliamentary Environmental Audit Committee says."

It would surely be a very serious mistake for planners to knowingly put future residents at risk from very harmful pollutants emanating from the A34. I hardly think that the Valley Park, North West Valley Park, East Harwell Campus and Milton Heights proposed development sites could be described as "far away from a major road".
