The Vale Local Plan 2031 is looking to develop employment in the South Oxfordshire Science Vale area. There is no employment in North Abingdon to sustain the very large community there. There is also no employment in Abingdon town that would support the local community. The vast majority of residents in North Abingdon have to travel to their place of employment. The individual motorcar is the predominant choice of transport taking individuals long distances to and from North Abingdon causing severe congestion.

By proposing to build 1000 new houses on Green Belt land in North Abingdon the Vale is failing to comply with its own Strategic Objective 8 of reducing the need to travel, it will in fact force residents of the proposed new houses in North Abingdon to travel long distances to find work.
