There are only two junctions on the A420 where land is designated for junction improvement, whereas there are many more junctions including the Littleworth & Thrupp junction where the increased traffic using the A420, due to the proposed housing development in neighbouring communities in the Vale and also the Swindon Borough Council development plan for the east of Swindon, will cause severe problems without a properly devised highway infrastructure plan.
