It is suggested that the plan text should be amended to make it more explicit about the need for an Oxfordshire-wide approach. This would ensure the Plan complies with Duty to Cooperate and should include the following:

The Council will continue to work jointly with all of the other Oxfordshire local authorities to address any unmet housing need. This includes engaging in an Oxfordshire wide approach which integrates housing provision, employment and infrastructure across the county to ensure coordinated, not piecemeal, planning. This will include assessing all reasonable spatial options, including the release of brown field land, the potential for new settlements and a full strategic review of the whole of the Oxford green belt. These issues are not for the Council to consider in isolation.

Should the outcome of joint working result in an element of unmet need being met within the Vale, the impact and infrastructure to support that growth would need to be looked at in combination with what has already been planned for in the district.
