3.1 The Council's Position 3.1.1 As it currently stands the Council's formal position in respect of growth at Radley is that set out within the draft Plan, i.e. proposed allocation of the land at North West Radley for 240 units and at South of Kennington for 270 units. As we have already made clear elsewhere in this submission, the Council's current approach is considered sound and the Freeholder supports the approach, most specifically the draft allocation at North West Radley.
