A Green Belt boundary can only be amended through a local plan. (NPPF para 83). We are not suggesting that an incorrect process has been followed, just that this section does not include a clear explanation of the process that has been followed, and could be read to imply that the Green Belt Review document has been adopted and the boundaries already changed, particularly in view of the text in the SA referred to below. As it is possible that the Green Belt may be altered in other areas it is important that all authorities are seen to follow a consistent process.

Suggest that CP13 is amended at the beginning to indicate that:

The Oxford Green Belt is amended in the following areas:
