Dear Sir/Madam,

I wish to object in the strongest possible terms to the proposed changes to green belt in Wootton, especially areas no. 10 & no. 9. My reasons are as follows:

- The loss of open spaces, which are some of the last in this area, any building on these green belt areas would result loosing a rural feel to the community.
- The increase in traffic on an already full-to-capacity minor road, Lamborough Hill, would be detrimental to the infrastructure.
- The loss of a fabulous view of Boars Hill from Lamborough Hill would impact on future generations and would severely damage the identity of Wootton village.
- Alternative non green belt areas, which there are enough in the area for further development, should be considered.
