- There would be poor visibility when exiting the proposed sites (e.g. the exit from site 24 would be onto a steep a hill with very poor visibility). The roads within the village are narrow and one way and would not withstand the significant increase in traffic volume. There have already been a number of local petitions submitted to the Council expressing concerns about the speed of traffic within the village and use by HGVs;
- 2) Botley Medical Centre is already at capacity and struggling to cope;
- 3) Cumnor Primary School is also full and has no scope/ space to develop further;
- 4) The Local Plan would see the removal of the local sports and leisure facilities within the village (namely, the football field and cricket club, both on land recommended for removal from the Green Belt). This would be in contravention of the Council's own healthy lifestyle initiatives.
