The Design Guide states that a minimum density of 30 dwellings per hectare should be achieved. Such a density should be restricted to the central areas of new developments. The existing housing on the boundary of both the Crab Hill and Grove airfield does not have such a density of housing and to put high density housing next to it would inappropriate. In the Design Guide there is no mention at all of bungalows. The Minister of State has said that Councils must do more to provide bungalows on new developments. Wantage and Grove already has a population with a large percentage in the 60 - 75 age band and this number will increase during the timeframe of the Local Plan. Surely there should be some provision for bungalows on the new estates.
