Please see below representations concerning the VWHDC's local plan, in particular plans to extend the village of Stanford in the Vale.

Stanford has always been a traditional large village, renowned for it's community spirit and the way in which residents work together for the benefit of the village. By planning to build an additional 200+ houses here, that community spirit will be destroyed. Generations of families have worked hard to provide this spirit and by making it into a small town, this will be destroyed for ever!!

Stanford is also built on a slight incline and houses at the bottom of the slight hill (along chapel road and Frogmore lane, church green and the bottom of Joyce's road) have already seen the impact of the recent David Wilson Homes development, as all of the surface water from the top if the village drains down to the bottom.
