Wilts & Berks Canal Policy 6.123 6.124

The Wiltshire Swindon & Oxfordshire Canal Partnership (Partnership) notes that the route of the restored Wilts & Berks Canal lies within two other Local Authority areas (Wiltshire and Swindon). The route has been protected in their Core Strategy and Local Plan respectively.

Therefore the VWHDC is considered to be under a duty to co-operate in order to protect the route in the VWHDC area. This is essential to allow a contiguous route for full 52 miles of the main line of the Wilts & Berks Canal restoration. Approximately 40% of the canal is in the VWHDC area.

Ideally the Partneship would prefer that VWHDC reverted to previous published policy (original reference 6.139) however the Partnership will work with VWHDC and all landowners to demonstrate how the waterway can be restored within the time-frame of the VWHDC Local Plan.

Therefore the Partnership in co-operation with Wilts & Berks Canal Trust (WBCT) provide the further information required to demonstrate sustainable delivery of the Wilts & Berks Canal in order to develop a suitable policy for Part 2 of the Local Plan.

In this respect the Partnership and WBCT seek further opportunities to assist the production of a deliverable MasterPlan for the relevant part canal in co-operation with VWHDC.

The Partnership seeks assurance from VWHDC that the saved Local Plan Policies (L14 & L15) are to be given full recognition within the Part 1 Plan in the interim period until a new policy is developed for Part 2?
