



Strategic sites are understandably excluded from CIL where infrastructure is provided by way of S106 agreements negotiated at outline planning permission time and subsequently in greater detail through executed agreements approved by Chair of Planning.

It will not necessarily be unusual for the number and or size of dwellings to change after those agreements are executed. Often extra units or larger footprints which had they been detailed earlier may have resulted in higher S106 payments. Where this happens I would be interested to understand what course of action the Council feels it best to follow. Options are presumably

- a) Do not amend S106 agreements and therefore forego potential infrastructure income
- b) Amend S106 agreements to reflect the additional infrastructural demand. But this may be costly and administratively burdensome unless this flexibility is built into the S106 at the outset.
- c) Choose to charge CIL on these sites which are otherwise exempt for any increases in units/footprint over and above the already negotiated S106 level.
