You must state which question your comment relates to. Question 5 The Fyfield site will add a further 600-700 more houses, populated by commuters, who will rely on the A420 and A415 to get to work. The proposed roundabout, allowing access to the site, will add to congestion at the Fyfield bottleneck on the A420 and encourage rat-running through surrounding villages. There are no mitigation measures proposed, or even conceivable, which will overcome the problems. The Fyfield site is remote from major employment opportunities, is in a rural setting, and unsuitable for such a large-scale development. Fyfield and Tubney Parish Council have submitted a thorough and detailed representation on Traffic Impacts of the development which I whole-heartedly support. It is clear to me that no development of this magnitude should be included in LPP2 before a comprehensive environmental assessment of its traffic impact is undertaken. As it stands, such an assessment will only be taken after its inclusion in the local plan and prior to planning permission being granted. Surely no developer will pay in the region of £85m for the land without a clear indication from the District Council that they will not refuse planning permission because the A420 and A415 cannot cope with the extra traffic. For this reason the proposed development might be INEFFECTIVE as well as UNSOUND.
