I tried to make my comments known using the online information but it was too difficult for me. This is not ideal, as it will put people off bothering to comment. Therefore I am making my comments in this email & hoping it finds the correct person.

I am a resident of Faringdon, I have lived here all my life. I was born here in 1966. As you can imagine I have seen many changes, positive & negative.

On your Local Plan 2031 Your map showing Faringdon has shown 'preferred' sites. It also shows our rural green areas outlined in blue which you state are 'suitable in principle'. Yes you have stated that these sites have not been put forward for development yet, but it is incredibly worrying that you have even assessed this land, also adding the possible amount of houses that could be accommodated here.

I really must stress my concern that you will end up allowing developers to build on all our surrounding rural fields & our rural town will be ruined forever.
