The area of land taken from the course would lead to the loss of membership, as it would no longer be a 'proper' golf course, and unable to attract interaction with other clubs to hold competitions. Development of junior members would be highly limited. Ultimately, being drained of resources a local business giving employment and social outlet would cease to be.
