Re. plans to improve access to major roads: *[... land is safeguarded by the Part 1 plan to support the delivery of the following transport schemes: „ South Abingdon-on-Thames Bypass linking the A415 to the west and south of the town, including a new River Thames crossing „ Diamond Interchange at the A34 Lodge Hill Junction....].* The access to major roads is absolutely key and must be addressed before building significant amounts of new housing. Traffic generated through Kennington and Abingdon by road users accessing the A34 from north Abingdon is already substantial and will be untenable if the housing is built before the access to the A34 is improved - the diamond junction MUST be built first
