In the Local Plan 2031 Part 2 Detailed Policies and Additional Sites Publication Version October 2017 Housing and Economic Land Availability Assessment(HELAA) Appendix 58: Wootton and on page 26 WOOT29 is INCORRECTLY stated as lying adjacent to the Ancient Woodland of Broom Hill Copse .

Broom Hill Copse is actually located on of Lincombe Lane which is shown in this OS Map

Also WOOT29 is not adjacent to the part of Blagrove Copse which is Ancient Woodland
