Core Policy 13 Oxford Green Belt, Core Policy 8 ? Spatial Strategy for Abingdon & Oxford fringe Sub Area & Core Policy 15 ? Spatial Strategy for SE Vale Sub Area: 3. The Vale?s uncritical acceptance of the SHMA figures as targets has led to the inappropriate allocation of sites within

the Green Belt and North Wessex Downs Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB). The plan has identified four development sites in the Green Belt to accommodate 1,510 houses, and two in the AONB for a total of 1,400 houses, which is threatening to undermine the rural character of the Vale. A further 11 sites are proposed for removal from the Green Belt. We are concerned that once land is removed from the Green Belt it will be at imminent risk of development, even if not immediately identified as a strategic site. *Green Belt* The Plan is inconsistent with planning guidance and government policies on the protection of Green Belts. The National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) makes it very clear that a Green Belt boundary may be altered only in ?exceptional circumstances?. Moreover, recent guidance (6 March 2014) states that: ?Unmet housing need (including traveller sites) is unlikely to outweigh the harm to the Green Belt and other harm to constitute the ?very special circumstances? justifying inappropriate development on a site within the Green Belt.? The Government's position on Green Belt policy, therefore, is very clear. The fundamental aim remains to prevent urban sprawl by keeping land permanently open. Boundaries of Green Belts should only be changed in "exceptional circumstances", and unmet housing need is not an exceptional circumstance to justify taking land out of the Green Belt.
