**Infrastructure Delivery Plan**

The further matter that needs closer scrutiny is the robustness of the VOWHDC Infrastructure Delivery Plan dated October 2014. Whilst the section 106 and CIL can be realistically expected to support some of the Housing growth infrastructure a substantial contribution will be administered by the Oxfordshire Local Enterprise Partnership (OxLEP), i.e. Government funding through Growth Places Fund, Local Sustainable Transport Fund etc. and through the Enterprise Zone Business Rates. I would encourage the Inspector to examine the robustness of this plan and the impact on the Local Plan if the identified funding and presumed Government commitments were to evaporate.
