There appears to be a discrepancy between the printed, circulated copy of the Local Plan and the web-based version that invites comments. In the printed copy East Challow is mentioned as a Local Service Centre along with others such as Shrivenham. In the web-based copy there is no mention of Local Service Centres, simply larger villages.

I wonder if there has simply been a mis-print of title and instead of Local Service Centre (on the printed copy) it should read "Larger Villages".

If this is not the case, I would be grateful if you would register a comment on the Local Plan to the effect that, at a recent meeting of West Challow Parish Council it was felt inappropriate that East Challow should be considered as a Local Service Centre, as due to its proximity to Wantage it cannot even support a local shop.
