2.4.12 In assessing whether CP4 and subsequently the Plan is effective, a judgement must be made as to whether or not it is deliverable over the Plan period. This requires evidence of: ? Sound infrastructure delivery planning; ? No regulatory or national planning barriers to delivery; ? Delivery partners who are signed up to it; ? Coherence with the strategies of neighbouring authorities; ? Flexibility and ability to be monitored.

2.4.13 It is noted that the evidence base for the Local Plan includes an Infrastructure Delivery Plan (IDP) (October 2014) which seeks to identify the infrastructure required to support development within VoWH in the period up to 2031, and how it will be delivered.
