Hi there,

Seeing as how I haven't had a response in a month I would like this email to be put forward as an objection to the strategic site proposed for Stanford in the Vale.

I strongly feel that an additional 200 houses in the village will fundamentally alter the nature and character of the village. We recently moved out of Oxford for a village lifestyle and the increasing growth of the village is not what we were hoping for in a rural community. I appreciate the need for more houses in the Vale but in my opinion this growth should be either a) concentrated in existing towns, which have a far greater capacity to absorb additional people without there being a strain on local services or facilities; or b) done by creating a new town which can be properly planned, rather than a haphazard and piecemeal development of existing villages.
