I consider the Local Plan does not consider infrastructure in Radley thoroughly enough and with due attention on timing. Radley?s roads are narrow and cannot support much more traffic at peak times. Sugworth Lane particularly is completely inadequate as, should the A34 have a Southbound exit at Lodge Hill, there will be much traffic from the intended settlement at Sandford Lane (so called South Kennington). Timing of the infrastructure is also important and should be done in advance of house building. The foul waste system in Radley is already failing and must be uprated before building houses. These aspects have not been carefully considered.
