I wish to register my strong objections to the proposal to take three areas of land out of the Green Belt in Wootton. I moved to Wootton just a year ago specifically because it is still a village with large open spaces including plot 10 which runs alongside the rear of my property. The view from the back of my house is very special and the fields are enjoyed by many villagers and walkers. The land also defines Wootton as a village and not a suburb of Abingdon. There are many other areas of land far more suited for development.

Secondly the main road running from Wootton to Abingdon is already extremely busy, very noisy and increasingly difficult to join from Home Close.

Development on plot 10 would have a severe impact on my privacy and also seriously devalue my property. The Vale should take the villagers objections very seriously and preserve its character and beauty rather than trying to destroy it.
