DRAINAGE AND FLOODING issues are a big concern.

I have read that Physical Requirements include:

- Upgrade the sewer network.
- A Drainage Strategy will be required.

Landscape considerations include:

• Further woodland planting to take place south of Lodge Hill.

Flood risk and drainage:

- Sustainable Urban Drainage (SUDs) methods will be used to drain the surface water from the development.
- A detailed Flood Risk Assessment for the site will be required, based on information available in the council's Strategic Flood Risk Assessment.
- Mitigation measures may be required to prevent any detrimental impact on groundwater quality.

My concerns

- In recent months every time we have heavy rain, we have had huge <u>flooding</u> at the roundabout at the bottom of Lodge Hill and Dunmore Road took several days to subside and traffic was swerving to avoid it.
- We live on a base of <u>clay</u> at his end of town. Clay, we know, does not drain water. I know this as my garden flooded soon after we moved in, and because the builders, Wates, had not adequately prepared for this: they had to tear down the fence and bring in diggers to put in a couple of soakways, and replace the topsoil.
- Alexander Close lies below the proposed development, and as we know water drains

- <u>down</u>. I am concerned that inadequate drainage will cause flooding on Dunmore Road, and roads such as Alexander Close.
- Specific detail is needed. What exactly does 'sustainable drainage systems' (SUDs) entail? What is the 'Drainage Strategy'? What mitigation measures are available? Does the Council's Strategic Flood Risk Assessment need to be updated in the light of the proposals.

My recommendations are:

- that adequate flood risk assessment is carried out well in advance, which would allow time to address further necessary investigations, recommendations and amendments and for the work to be carried out properly, with adequate planning, funding, execution, plus examination to check it has been correctly done.
- that the flood risk assessment should be accurate and based on <u>real rainfall data of recent times</u>, not simply averages of years past. We all know that climate change is resulting in more extremes of weather.
- that the <u>arithmetic of risk is clearly set out and transparent</u>, not simply a conclusion of risk percentages
- and that should the risk is proved great that there would be time and opportunity for these to be addressed before proceeding.

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TRAFFIC								
There will be 800 houses (Abingdon North) plus a further 200 in Abingdon NW. Given car ownership is 80% according to 2012 National Travel Survey, and ownership is likely to be higher in this area, the developments have a potential of an extra 800 cars minimum. Traffic will be substantially increased. There would certainly be further long hold-ups on what should be a free-flowing road, causing tail-backs and pollution from car emissions.

My recommendations:
Rather than feed into Dunmore Road, which already has problems for traffic turning right and left out of the side roads, a <u>new road</u> should be built at the northern end of the proposed estate, running parallel, at the top of the hill, to the A34.
Further detailed assessment is needed, statistics of potential increase usage, and pollution.
If there is to be an interchange for the A34 then the building of this new access road would dovetail into those works.
