The capacity issues on the A420 will not be satisfactorily addressed by local junction improvements, as local people who use the road daily at peak times already know. The dual carriageway sections at Southmoor are at a standstill with traffic volume at rush hours, in spite of the dualling of the road and enlargement of roundabouts. This congestion has extended to Faringdon, and will simply deteriorate further if the projected density of settlement along the A420 is allowed to go ahead.
