The NPPF makes it very clear that green belt boundaries may only be altered in "exceptional circumstances". Recent government guidance on interpreting NPPF (6 March 2014) states that: "Unmet housing need (including traveller sites) is unlikely to outweigh the harm to the green belt and other harm to constitute the "very exceptional circumstances" justifying inappropriate development on a site within the green belt." Nowhere in the green belt review of February 2014 does it make clear the "exceptional circumstances" that justify the removal of large areas from the green belt.
