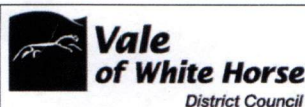

Policy 4: As a resident of Cumnor I am personally appalled by the lack of consultation & the speed with which the Vale of White Horse has tried to impose the local plan on all the residents. No real contact has been made with residents to consult properly. The website is confusing & almost impossible to navigate for feedback. The lack of transparency of the process is unacceptable. Independent expert advice has been ignored. The SHMA housing market Assessments are figures are not only inflated but unsound + not sustainable. **Policy 13**: This is the most objectional part of the Plan. The proposed removal of the 5 sites ^{from the} Green Belt around Cumnor village is unacceptable, with no foresight regarding preservation of village community life + fields for walks + fresh air. This should be stopped as it smacks of an underhand approach to "steal the green belt" for future unsustainable developments.

Policy 7 moreover Cumnor is already crowded & the local school & traffic jams will only increase ^{is full to capacity}. There is a lack of infrastructure to support the plan. Cumnor is FULL — There is no more space to expand further.

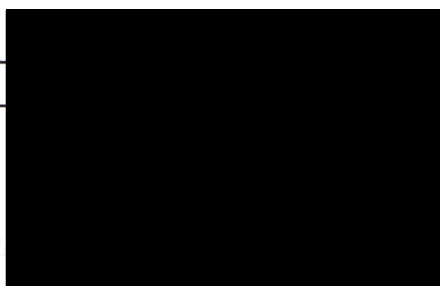
