The current proposal incorrectly state that growth in the South of Abingdon is not recommended because it will add to traffic constraints on the Drayton Road, the mini-roundabouts and Marcham Road/Oct Street. Along with increased usage of the Abingdon Bridge towards Culham, these are the roads that any North Abingdon residents are likely to use to access the planned jobs in the Science Vale. The plan is fundamentally flawed and unsound. This should be about long term planning but the Southern Abingdon bypass and new river crossing do not for part of this plan. If they did, then the distribution of housing might be very different and Green Belt North of Abingdon would not be required.
