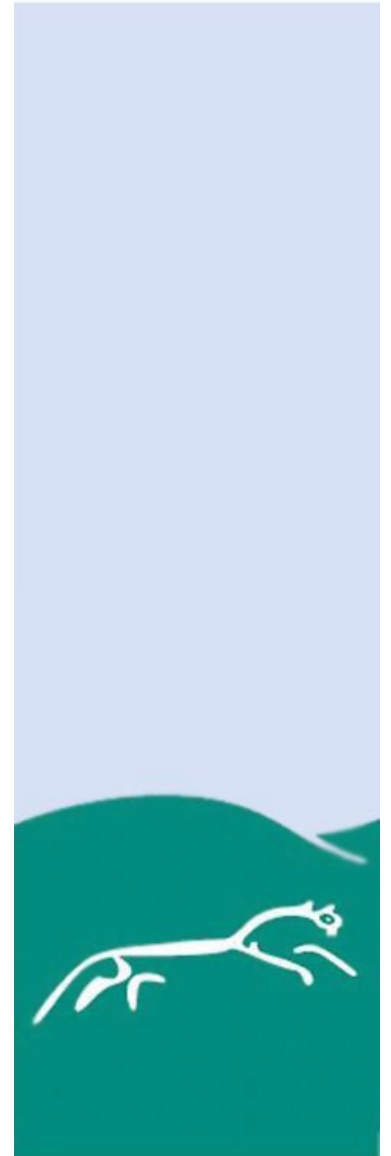

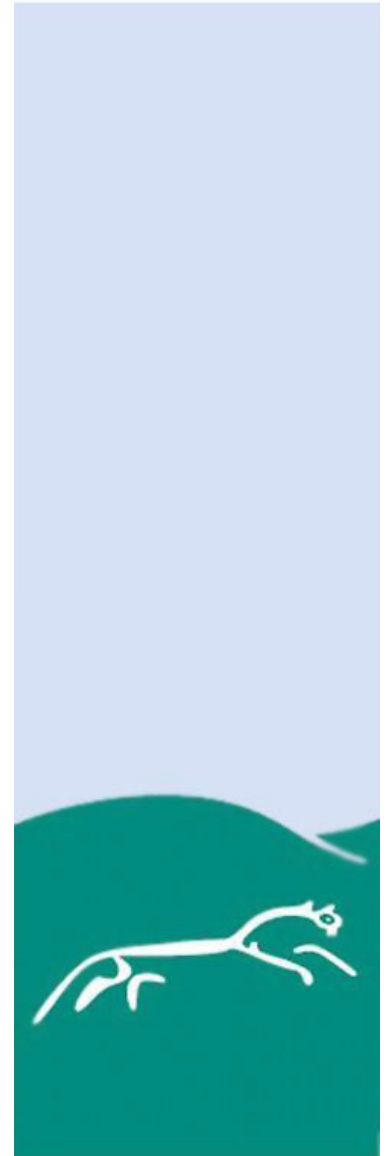

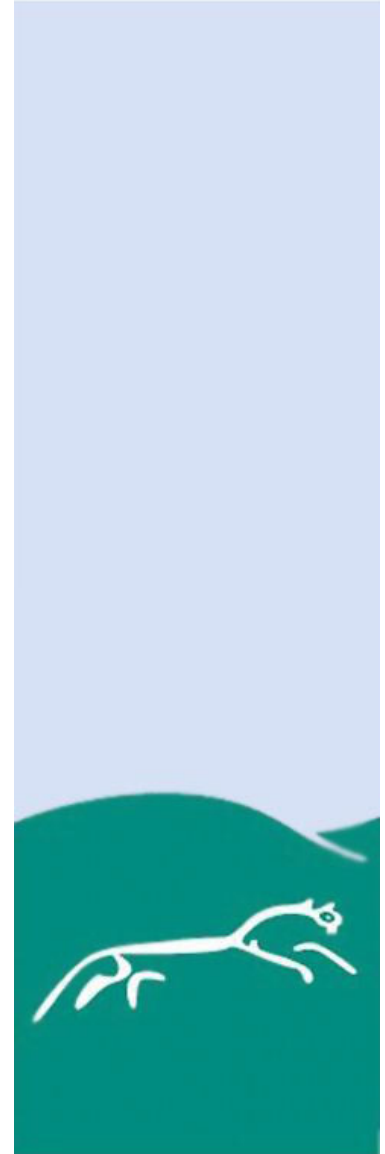
# The Big Picture - content

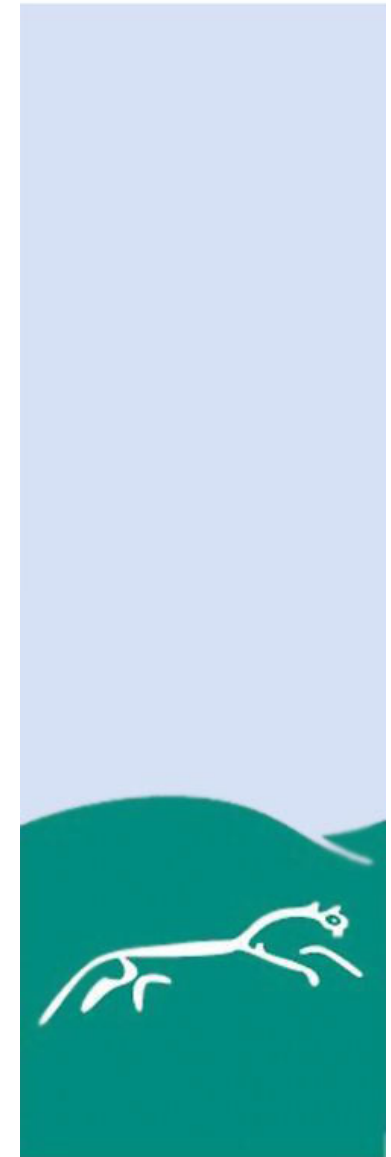
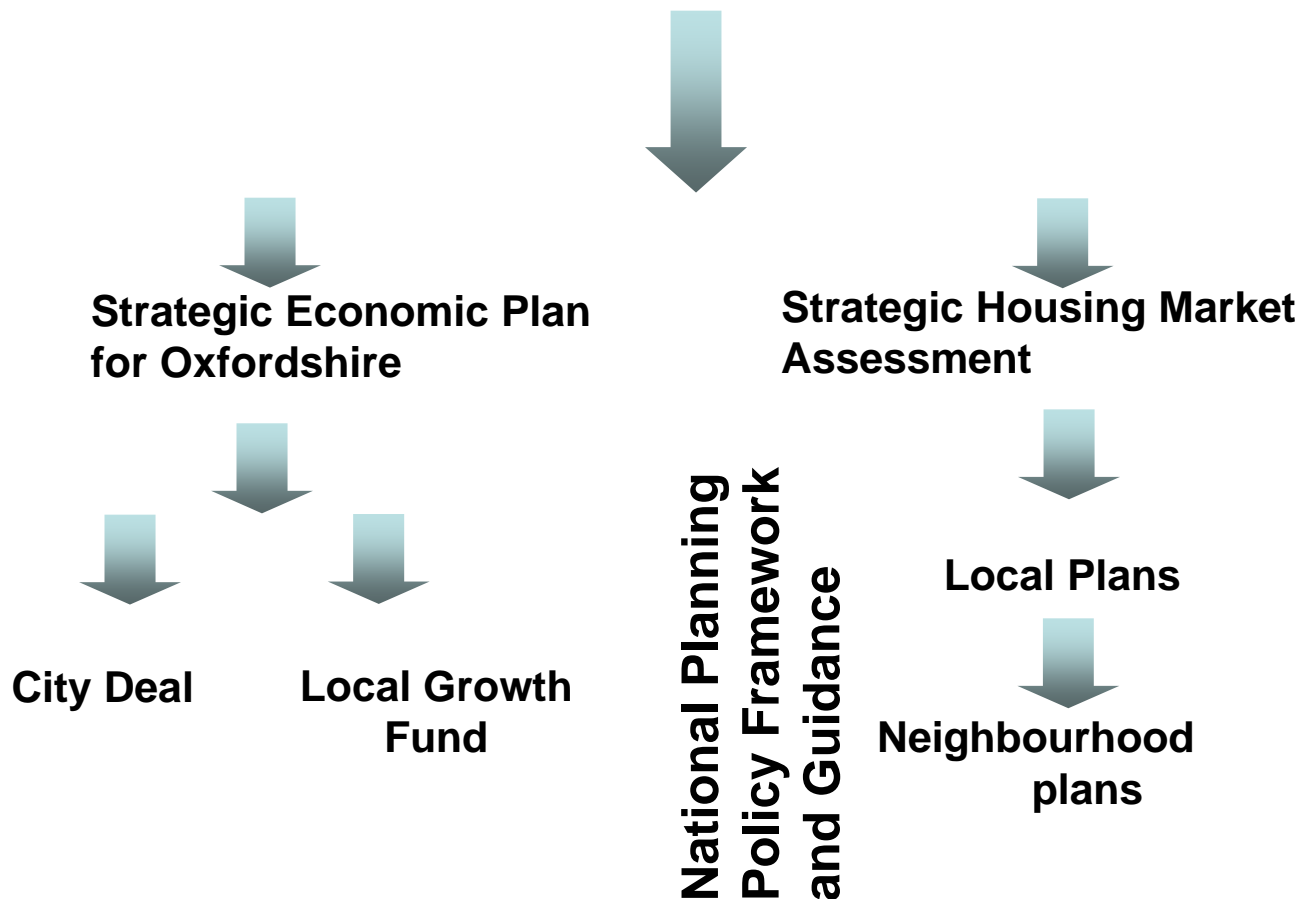


# SHMA - Duty to cooperate

- Housing numbers to be provided in Oxfordshire may increase
- Each council must seek to meet its own needs
- If a council cannot accommodate its own needs other councils must help
- Cherwell, Vale and West have no up-to-date plans; progressing to examination 2014
- South and Oxford city may have to refresh local plans
- Neighbourhood plans must comply with the local plan so possibly some impact

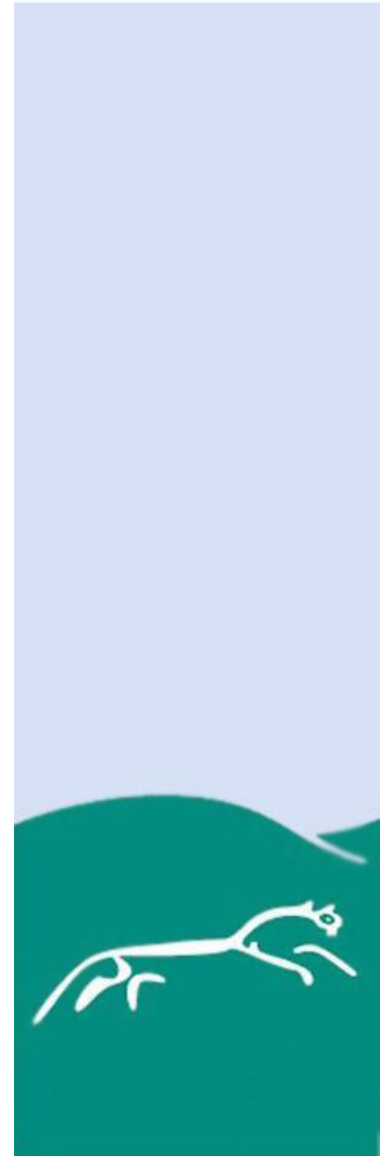

# Key Events

- Strategic Economic Plan (SEP) draft submitted by LEP to Govt in December
- Ambition of SEP will determine Local Growth Fund allocation to LEP from 2015 (£2bn a year for 5 years)
- City Deal decision imminent (c£100m)
- SHMA published Jan 2014
- Assess implications for emerging Vale Local Plan
- Keep town and parish councillors updated
