LOCAL PLAN PART 2 EXAMINATION

The Local Plan 2031 Part 2: Detailed Policies and Additional Sites was submitted to the Secretary of State on Friday 23 February 2018 for independent Examination.

Following Submission, the Secretary of State appointed Mr David Reed as the Planning Inspector to carry out the independent Examination to assess if the Plan meets the Government's requirements for Local Plans.

The Hearings are taking place over a three-week period. The first two weeks were held at Abingdon and Witney College in July this year.

The third week will take place at the Beacon, Portway, Wantage and commences on Tuesday 4 September.

SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENTS


We mentioned earlier in the year that initial work was underway to prepare Supplementary Planning Documents (SPDs) for Harwell Campus and Dalton Barracks.


