

Supplementary Planning Document Open Space, Sport and Recreation Future Provision

Adoption Statement

The Vale of White Horse District Council adopted the Supplementary Planning Document Open Space, Sport and Recreation Future Provision on 16th July 2008. This adoption statement is required by Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004.

Any person aggrieved by the Supplementary Planning Document Open Space, Sport and Recreation Future Provision may make an application to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the Supplementary Planning Document.

Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the Supplementary Planning Document was adopted.
