We would like to object to parts of the Vale of White Horse new housing development sites 5, 6 and 7 : South Kennington, North Radley & north west Radley.

Our household only received ONE proposal delivered. Residents without online facility would have found it difficult to respond. More info & coverage was reqd. The plan is totally unsound with unrealistic infrastructure in place. Pressure on schools, doctors, transport will result. Major pollution through more traffic will create health problems. Plans 5 & 6 would radically change the character and dynamic of Kennington and Radley. Loss of green space will lead and encourage obesity. I object 100% on development sites 5 and 6.
