

Dear Sir or Madam,

I am writing to say that I disagree with the plans to build more houses in North Abingdon as stated in the Local Plan Part One 2031.

The plans are unsound and have not taken the local infrastructure and needs of the people into account. The roads around Abingdon are already full to capacity especially in the morning and afternoon. There are regular queues towards the Marcham roundabout, and it is often very difficult to turn right out of any of the roads off the ring road (Twelve Acre Drive). More houses will mean many more cars, and those situations will be worsened.

Furthermore, schools and amenities in the area are full with more school places already needed for the next years and with some local children not being able to go to the same school as their siblings. More houses will exsaserate this problem.
