I would like to object to the review of Green Belt proposals affecting Wootton Village.

I have lived in the village for 27 years and during this time have seen various changes. Two large estates have been built, one of which was to include a business park. Only one office building has been completed and the remaining land could be used as a Brownfield Site for new housing.

We are affected by flooding, as too are other areas in and around the village. The drainage system seems to be inadequate and with extra housing this could exacerbate the problem.

Changing the Green Belt would mean loss of privacy, countryside, open spaces, views and rural feel of the village. Extra housing would increase traffic and noise which has become very apparent over the years.

Alternative non-Green Belt areas should be used for houses. The aim of the Green Belt is to protect our countryside and safeguard it for future generations and not to change the boundaries for residential use.

I hope you will consider my comments and objections favourably.
