It is a fact that residents living in North Abingdon do not just work in Oxford or the Science Vale. They work all over the country using, predominantly, individual motorcars as transport. Members of the Vale planning team themselves live in other counties and do not use public transport or cycling or walking. It is unrealistic to suggest that 'new' residents' of North Abingdon will cycle or walk to work any more than existing residents as they will also be travelling all over the country on their own.

The suggestion that the Vale can reduce congestion and by improving public services, walking and cycling is wishful thinking, if it can be done why hasn't it been done before now.

There is no employment in North Abingdon and certainly not sufficient employment in the Abingdon area to support the thousands of people living there. Motorcars will remain the only viable choice of transport for the majority of residents.

There is no evidence that improving public services, walking, cycling or efficient use of cars is likely to have any significant impact on reducing the potential of very serious and strangling traffic congestion.
