The "local Green Belt Review" (para 5.40, p62) was no such thing. It was a search for housing sites in the Vale's portion of the Oxford Green Belt. In paragraph 1.21, pages 16-17 of the Local Plan Strategic Sites and Policies document, the Council sets out how the Vale Council will work with the County Council and other Oxfordshire District Councils to complete an Oxfordshire-wide Strategic Green Belt Review. No land should be removed from the Vale's portion of the Green Belt and no strategic sites should be allocated until this review is completed

Delete all references to the "local Green Belt Review.
