The current projection of employment in the Vale suggests that all jobs will be created in the East of the District. However jobs are being created in Faringdon and the Western Vale. Greater emphasis

and planning should be put on economic development and employment in the Western Vale. By supporting job creation in Faringdon and the surrounding area the pressures upon transport arising as a result of the increased numbers of houses will be reduced. VOWH needs a parrallel plan for job creation, rather than focussing all efforts on planning for housing.
