The Vale of White Horse Council's comments on the Green Belt review of February 2014 deemed it that 2 sites namely 4 & 5 were inappropriate as they lay in the Cumnor Conservation Area and therefore "removing them from the Green Belt would serve no purpose". Why without any consultation has the Vale now reversed its position and included in the Cumnor Plan?

Site numbers 6 & 24 have been withdrawn from the plan as being unsuitable for housing. If thats the case why should it not remain in the Green Belt.

Removing all the Cumnor 5 sites from the Green Belt inevitably will lead to housing redevelopment. This whole exercise is based on excessive calculation for future housing and should be rejected or greatly modified with the exclusion of GREEN BELT areas identified.
