Subject: Wootton: Proposed Changes

Dear Sir,

My wife, daughter and I would all like to register our strong opposition to any development on the Wootton Green Belt area. Having recently had our surgery close down and with pressure on schooling and transport in the area this seems to make little sense. This is apart from the fact that it would destroy open spaces and views between Wootton and Boars Hill which would be at the eternally lasting detriment of the village.

There are far more sensible places to build on - the District Council should be focussing on brown field and staying away from village green belt that help to provide the distinctness and separation that our rural villages need.

I am not against new housing but I am against new housing on green belt - especially when I think there are alternatives and areas that already provide the required infrastructure to cope with the additional pressure that new houses invariably brings and is often not thought through.
