I am writing to express my concerns over the Green Belt Review, specifically page 65 of the 77, showing land ?recommended for further examination for potential exclusion from the Green Belt?. The stated aims having a Green Belt would be severely compromised should the protected status be removed. My concerns range from changing the nature of, in this case, Wootton village, to the potential problems for infrastructure caused by using the land for housing in the future, and many other considerations in between.
