

Flooding is a significant issue for East Hanney and building 200 houses upstream on Letcombe Brook will exacerbate that problem because of the additional surface run off from the housing area. It is important that there remains a wildlife corridor along Letcombe Brook and that the planned housing finishes a suitable distance from the Brook.

The historic orchard area should be kept intact.

There does not appear to be any plans for an expansion of sewerage to meet the extra loading on an already overstretched system. Additional housing should not take place without an improvement to the sewerage system.

The extra housing will adversely affect traffic on the already very congested A338. The village is lacking in any significant basic amenities. People only buy very few items in the village shop and most peoples shopping will be from a larger centre with more extensive shops. There is no GP or dentist. The village primary school is virtually at capacity and with limited potential for expansion. Most people make use of their car rather than use the bus service. There is no safe sensible cycle route to Grove and Wantage.

It is incomprehensible that East Hanney is designated as a large village considering the facilities that are available.
